

Minor typographical errors in
Interactive Operations Research with Maple: Methods and Models
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(I would like to thank Dr. Sabih Atadan and Carol Mercier for pointing out some of the following typos.)

- Page 7, line 18: Replace “ x , y and z ” by “ x and y ”.
- Page 7, line 21: Delete “ $z:=z$:”
- Page 73, line –6: In the definition of `inventory`, replace “`uH`” by “`xH`” and re-run the worksheet `TPBVP.mws`. This will result in a slight change in the output on page 74.
- Page 174: In worksheet `CONSQUAL.MWS`, in “`eq[2]`” towards the bottom of the page replace “`grad_g2[1]`” by “`grad_g1[2]`”. When this typo is corrected and when the worksheet is executed, Maple no longer produces a solution. This means that the paragraph starting immediately after Figure 5.3 on page 175 should be revised as follows: “As we see, Maple cannot find a solution to this problem. What went wrong?”
- Page 198, line 2: Replace “to a state in state i ” by “to a state in stage i ”.
