  - Expected completion times?
- Completed last week.
  - Research done?
  - Paper written?
  - Paper submitted?
- 3. Please write these as formal reports.

- Check grammar.
- Check spelling.
- Remember that referees will judge the quality of your research **and** the quality of your writing.
- When you submit papers, they will ask,
  - Is the work original?
  - Is it interesting?
  - Is the math correct?
  - Is it well-written?
